Our Achievement

- For every 10,000 steps achieved, a total of HK\$1.6 million was raised to benefit charitable organisations dedicated to ocean conservation and coastal cleanups.
- * A total of **700 million steps achieved** can be converted into:
 - > 11 complete cycles around the Earth
 - Round trip from Hong Kong to Pacific Ocean for 37 times

Ocean Conservation Impact and Community Engagement in 2023



 Coastal cleaning events were held in collaboration with NGOs in Hong Kong, and clean ups events at trail or coastal in the Mainland.



- Partnered with Everwave to collect 18,400kg of waterway waste in Cambodia.
- Collaborating with the Narwhal Ocean Research Centre, targeted to recover around
 2,400 kg of abandoned fishing gear in the Mainland.



• 200 corals will be planted in the coastal area of Shenzhen Dapeng Bay to contribute to coral reef restoration
